Notice:

Due to current pandemic issues each site is tentative and may be cancelled at any time. There is no guarantee that a site will be open. In the event that a site is forced to close we will do everything we can to find an alternative site but there are no guarantees and no rescheduling from current dates. The qualifications were extended until March 28th in order to accommodate facilities and CV-19 issues. There are also no guarantees that a national event will be held. In the event that a site is closed and a shooter unable to compete a complete refund for registration will be issued to the shooter. Each site also has facility and occupancy restrictions that may be different from other sites. Each shooter and those accompanying the shooter must adhere to the regulations. No exceptions.

Be prepared for mask and restrictions on all participants, including non shooters. . Health check may take place in order to enter the building. Anyone who displays any symptom of illness will not be allowed to compete. By registering for this match, you agree to abide by site restrictions regardless of USAS and ISSF rules such as spectators and coaches in the building. (These rules have been suspended by USAS) Refusal to abide by the rules will result in immediate withdrawal from the match and removal of the participants. Most of the sites require disinfecting after each relay and this will take some time. We are doing our best to give the kids an opportunity to compete but we have to abide by restrictions placed on each site, and each site may be different. These restrictions are non-negotiable. Due to the increased sites number of sites and new facility use fees we have to raise the entry fee. TSRA is doing all it can to continue recognition of all levels of shooters, not just the top three.

No multiple site registrations allowed. In the event your site is cancelled we will do everything we can to get you in another site. No lane assignment is guaranteed until the registration form and fees are in the hands of the host!

CITIES/STATE LOCATION:

Ft Worth, El Paso, Rosenberg, Victoria, Amarillo, Granbury (Air Rifle Only)

ELIGIBILITY:

This competition is open to all competitors born in 2001 or later.
All competitors must be individual members of USA Shooting and TSRA. You can join each of these organizations online prior to the match or at the match. Membership numbers will be required upon registration.

RESIDENCE:

Each competitor may claim residence in only one state and must declare the state of residence on the entry form. Residents are eligible for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place USA Shooting State Championship medallions. Non-Residents may compete for invitations to the National Championship and are encouraged to do so. Non-residents are not eligible for USAS state awards. **All competitors are eligible for state TSRA awards.**

Residency is defined as to where the competitor holds a current and valid driver's license. If the competitor does not have a driver's license, residency is then defined as the residence of the competitor's parents/guardians.

ENTRY:

Only scores from a registered State Junior Olympic match will count for invitation to the National Junior Olympic Championships. **Shooters may not compete in more than one state JO Qualification Match.** Juniors who fire in their own home state JOSCA will not be allowed to shoot in another state. Juniors from states which are not holding a state JO Qualification Match, and those who cannot attend their own state JO Qualification Match, will be allowed to enter as a non-resident in another state. Non-residents should declare their home state at entry and are not eligible for USA Shooting state resident awards.

All entries must include the competitors home address, phone number, and e-mail.
No school addresses allowed.

CATEGORIES:

The following categories will be used for the competition: (Based on the age the competitor will be in the year 2021.) Junior (J1); age 18-20; competitors born from 2001-2003 Intermediate Junior (J2); age 15-17; competitors born from 2004-2006 Sub-Junior (J3); age 14 & under; competitors born in 2007 or later.

CLASSIFICATION:

Male / Female

RULES:

The Current ISSF rules will govern.

COURSES OF FIRE:

Air Rifle (10m)

Women and Men; 60 shots, all standing.

Smallbore Rifle (50') – 3x20 for all.

No Finals will be conducted for any competition at any location.

TIME LIMITS:

Electronic Targets

Air Rifle, 1 hour 15 minutes

Small-bore 1 hour 45 minutes

Orion in Stages

(two targets per stage)

Air Rifle 1 hour 30 minutes

Small-bore 2 hours

FIREARMS:

Air Rifles – .177 caliber air rifle.

Smallbore Rifle – .22 caliber smallbore rifle.

(See USAS/ISSF Shooting Rules for specifics on both)

SIGHTS:

Metallic only.

COACHING:

Verbal coaching on the firing line will not be permitted. Shooter may request coaching, but through the Range Officer only & must safely leave the firing line to meet with the coach. Non verbal hand signals from the spectator area is permitted as long as it does not distract other shooters. **See facility restrictions notice.**
Coaches may be restricted to the outside of the building according to each individual site restrictions.

No electronic devices capable of receiving signals allowed. Timers or stop watches are allowed as long as they do not receive any electronic messages and are used for timing only.

TIES:

All ties will be broken in accordance with the USA Shooting Rules.

PARTICIPATION PINS:

One per competitor.

AWARDS:

USA Shooting – 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place medallions (gold, silver, & bronze) for resident overall winners.

TSRA – Will give one award for every five competitors each classification and category per event.

MAKING ENTRY:

Initially, contact the match director at the location in which you intend to participate for squadding and pre-registration information. All fees & paperwork must be completed properly before competing. Be sure and arrive early enough to finalize the paperwork & fees prior to your relay time. **Current USA Shooting & TSRA membership is required.** Please provide the membership numbers on the pre-registration forms which include a USA Shooting entry form. If you are shooting both events (air & small-bore rifle) then two USA Shooting entry forms must be submitted, one for each event. Use the Contact information above for your location to obtain pre-registration information, schedule your relay and generate a packet for you on match day. Firing positions are assigned on a first come, first serve basis. Payment must be received to reserve your firing position. It is important to contact the match coordinator at the site you wish to compete at for registration information and lane assignments prior to arriving for the match.

MATCH ENTRY FEE:

\$35 per shooter per event

The entry fees do include the USA Shooting sanctioning fees. All fees & paperwork will be completed on match day. The entry fee for the match does not include membership fees! Junior USA Shooting memberships are \$30 (1 year) and TSRA memberships are \$5 (1 year).
